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Isaac is an appellate advocate and commercial litigator, helping clients navigate business and regulatory disputes. Isaac also regularly prepares amicus briefs for industry associations, non-profit organizations, and healthcare entities, and is often asked to serve as embedded appellate counsel during trial, handling motions in limine, jury instructions, and post-trial briefing.

On the regulatory side, Isaac represents corporations and individuals in administrative hearings and government investigations. He regularly appears before the Washington State Office of Administrative Hearings, the Washington State Office of the Insurance Commissioner, and the Washington State Board of Industrial Insurance Appeals. His strategic guidance and straightforward advice help clients obtain the best results in any dispute, whether it is resolving an investigation by consent order or challenging a legal issue on appeal.
